Ladies and gentlemen.

As part of *The 6th European Month of Photography Berlin*, Galerie Kornfeld presents the exhibition *Les Euronautes* from 16th October to 15th November, 2014.

Upheavels and Utopias. The Other Europe is the theme for The 6th European Month of Photography Berlin in 2014. Our exhibition presents four photographers searching for Europe's intrinsic identity.

The 21st century with its open borders and world wide connectivity is putting the old structures of an already heterogeneous Europe into question. Is there, or was there ever a united European idea? Is there such a thing as a European identity? Who today is actually European?

None of the artists in the exhibition explicitly address these topics, yet the question of a possible European identity can be perceived in all works featured in the exhibition.

In **Stéphane Couturier's** formally impressive photographs of the antique sculptures at the *Gläsernes Depot* of the Dresden Albertinum, the classical ideal of the naked human body is evident.

Whilst the work of Couturier pays homage to Greek and Roman antiquity as the cradle of European culture, **Camilla Douraghy**, a Swiss artist with Persian roots, plays with antique poses and motifs, staging male and female nudes of different skin colour as antique sculptures.

The series *Different Persons* by **Ralf Peters** questions our recognition of individuality. Although not related to each other, the typical Northern European faces of the portrayed women resemble one another to an astonishing degree – an effect further enhanced by his use of the 'passport photo' concept.

The works of **Benyamin Reich**, an Israeli of European heritage, show how Jewish traditions live on in Europe, whilst also transmitting an outsider's perspective of Europe as the continent of forests and swamps, of snow and rivers.
